Let's Design It Together!



A flag is more than just a symbol; it's a powerful emblem of community spirit - a visual representation of who we are. As Apopka continues to grow and evolve, we need a unique flag to reflect our city's identity. This contest invites our community to come together and create that symbol.

A few things first:

All entries will be judged based on the North American Vexillological Association's Five principles of good design:

- 1) Keep it simple: The flag should be so simple that a child can draw it from memory.
- 2) Use meaningful symbolism: The flag's images, colors or patterns should relate to what it symbolizes.
- 3) Use two-three basic colors: Limit the number of colors on the flag to three, which contrast well and come from the standard color set.
- 4) No lettering or seals: Never use writing of any kind or an organization's seal.
- 5) Be distinctive or be related: Avoid duplicating other flags, but use similarities to show connections.
